

During the consultation period, it was brought to our attention that parents were concerned that the addition of a third feeder school may put local families at a disadvantage.

The admission policy has already taken this into consideration. Should the school be unable to admit all children from the named feeder infant schools, applicants will be ranked within this category in accordance with any of the additional priorities below:

- i) Catchment
- ii) Children who have a brother or sister (living in the same household) at the school already on roll and who will still be attending the school the following academic year.
Note – this category does include step-brothers/step-sisters, adoptive brothers/sisters living within the same household or children whose parents are married or cohabiting and live together within the same household
- iii) Children eligible for service premium
- iv) Children of staff employed at the school (or school on an adjacent site)
- v) Children who live closest to the school, based on the shortest distance from home to school, measured 'as the crow flies'. (This distance will be used where necessary to prioritise applications).
