Titanic's Legacy

At the very end of last week's Titanic virtual tour you might have heard the presenter explain about one of the ways how things have changed at sea since the Titanic's sinking. If you didn't, don't worry, you are now going to learn about how the sinking of the Titanic caused changes. This is known as the legacy of Titanic.

Hopefully now you should know a little more about the 3 areas of Titanic's legacy so let's now have a go at matching up the picture to the legacy!

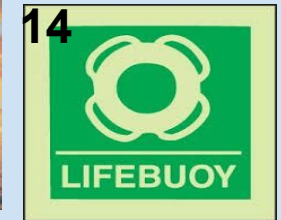
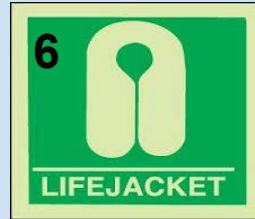
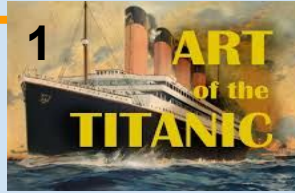
On the next slide is a table with the 3 parts to the Titanic's legacy. Look at the pictures and work out which part of the Titanic's legacy each picture is representing.

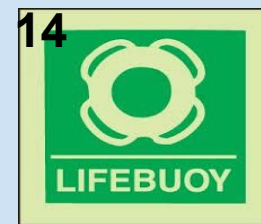
