Dear Parents,

Yesterday was a day of mixed feelings for me as we welcomed back 53 of our year 6 pupils. Watching them greet each other and their teachers with smiles and seeing how quickly they adapted to the new routines to keep them safe brought me such happiness. Then I thought about our year 3, 4 and 5 pupils who are continuing to stay at home and this gave me feeling of sadness, realising quite how much I am missing them all.

This week as a school we will be balancing teaching year 6 pupils in school, caring for increasing numbers of pupils of key workers, and continuing to provide home learning and support for those pupils at home. The majority of staff are now working in school and with pupils, full time. We will endeavour to maintain the quality of home learning we have provided, but may offer a variety of activities for pupils to choose from rather than lesson plans for all subjects. For year 6 pupils, we will be signposting resources that they can use to continue learning at home.

Teachers will continue to look at work that your child shares with them so please encourage them to do this.
