In English, we have been retelling the story of Theseus and the Minotaur. The children enjoyed rewriting the story and then writing their own version of a myth.



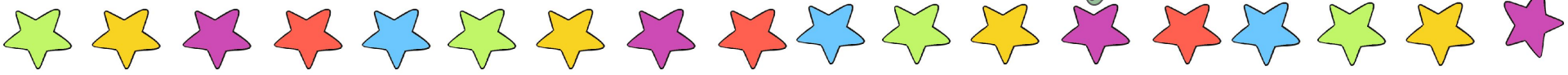

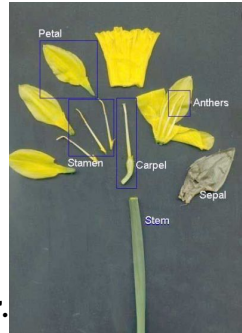


In History, we have gone all the way back to the Ancient Greeks! We have learnt about Gods, Myths and the ideas of famous philosophers!
